2018 MIDTERM ELECTIONS



MIDTERM ELECTIONS IN ILLINOIS WILL DETERMINE MANY CRITICAL SEATS

A general election will be held in Illinois on November 6, 2018. All of Illinois' executive officers will be up for election, including governor and lieutenant governor. Illinois residents will be voting to fill Illinois' eighteen seats in the United States House of Representatives and all 118 seats of the Illinois House of Representatives. Illinois will hold general elections for circuit court judge vacancies on November 6th, as well.

It is important to make an informed judicial vote so we created a resource page for you with information compiled about each judicial candidate by the Illinois Bar Association. The judges you elect have a major impact on our court system. This is an extremely important election and your vote does COUNT!
